## UNIVERSITY OF AUCKLAND

Dr Barry Reay has been appointed to a newly-established lectureship in History. Previously at the South Australian College of Advanced Education, he is a specialist in early modern history. He will offer a third-year paper on popular culture in early modern Europe. Dr James Belich has joined the department as a post-doctoral fellow for 1982. He will offer a third-year paper on Victorian Ideas of Race and their impact on New Zealand.

Professor Sorrenson and Associate-Professor Stone are both on research and study leave. The former will spend most of the year in London; the latter will spend part of the year in New Zealand, part overseas.

Professor Sinclair has been elected President of the New Zealand Historical Association and Mrs Bassett Secretary.
