New Zealand's first naturalist and conservationist, Henry went to Australia from Ireland in the 1850s as a small boy. He grew up in Victoria before coming to New Zealand in the 1860s. Henry took up the position of Curator of Resolution Island in Dusky Sound in 1894 and his account of the natural history of the sound, his close relationship with its wildlife, and his extraordinary efforts to save New Zealand's ground-dwelling birds from extinction, are thoroughly dealt with in this definitive biography. Also included are details of his time spent as a ranger on Kapiti Island before he retired to Katikati.
